Design theorist Tony Fry will present the concept and practice of 'metrofitting' as a basis of addressing the global risks and challenges faced by cities - including rapid urbanisation/informalization, population pressures, metabolic breakdown, current and coming climate change impacts, governance and conflict.

Although the perspective of the talk will be global it will make clear how the issues to be raised exist on multiple scales and touch 'the local', and in so doing will prompt questions and discussion about the future of Hobart, Launceston, urban Tasmania in general and the future of professional practice.
